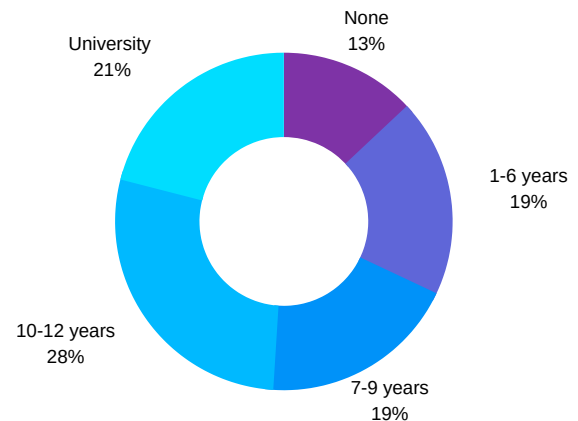

Student Areas of Origin 2019



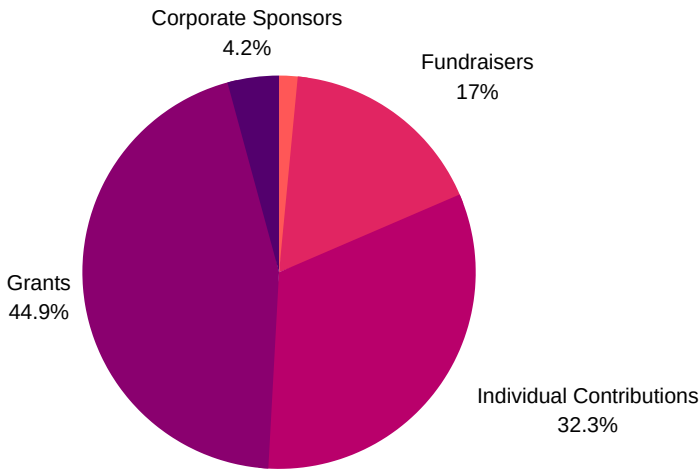
Level of Education in Country of Origin

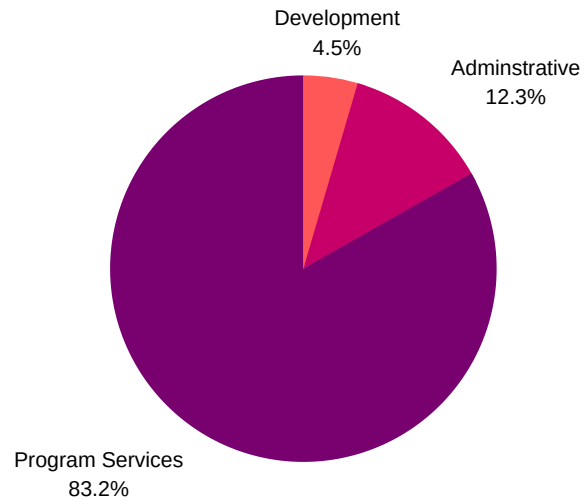
