- Conducted 6,343 hours of one-on-one instruction

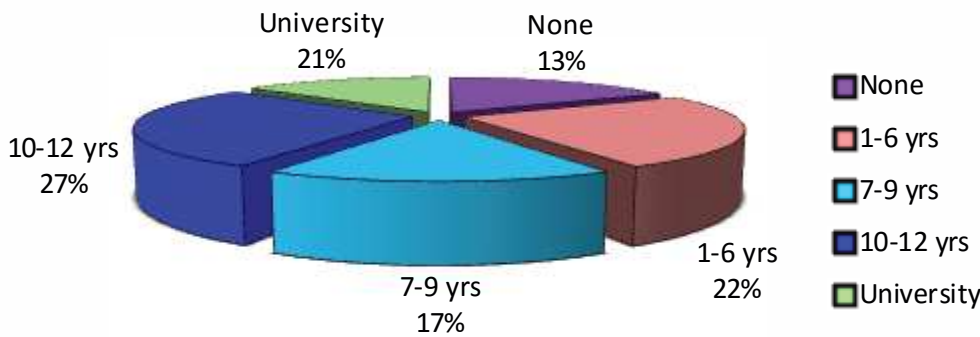


Our Students

Level of Education in Country of Origin

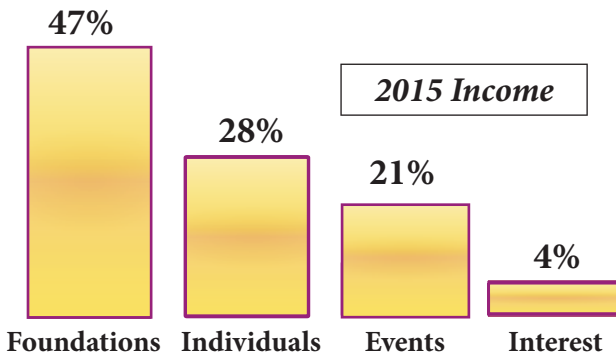

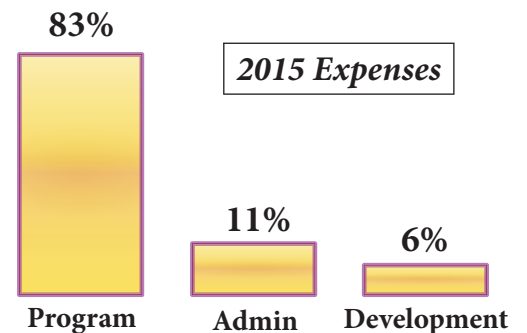

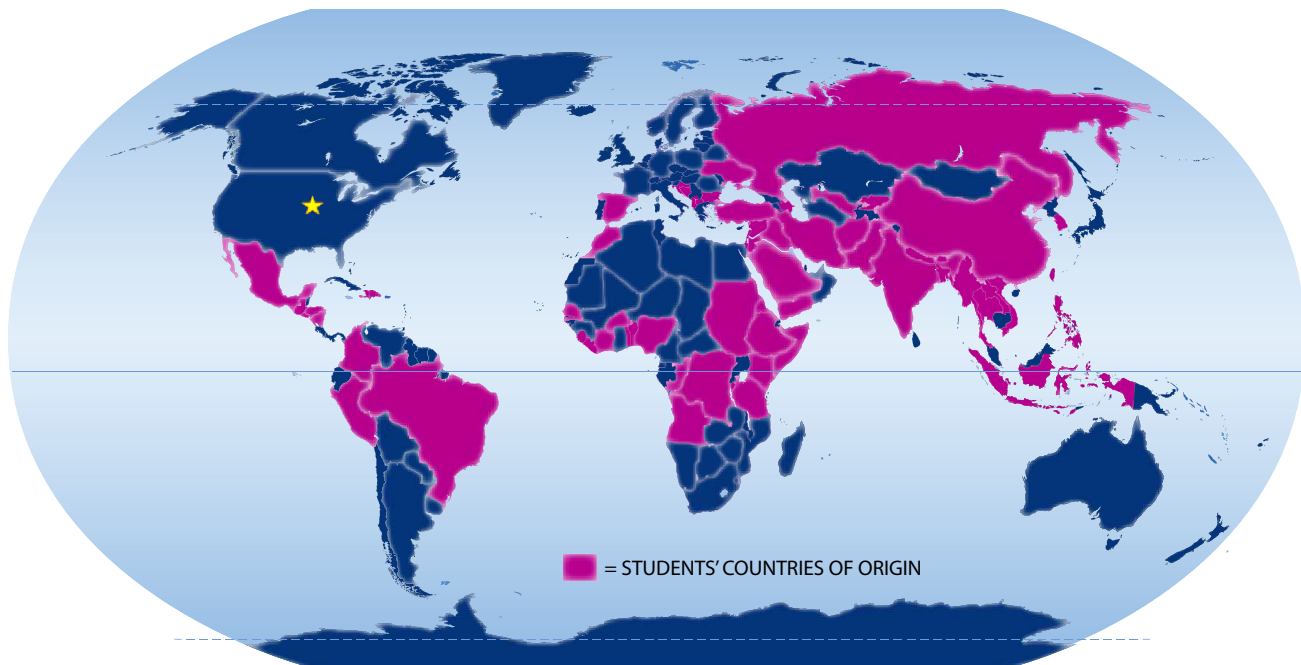
