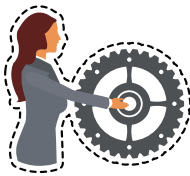

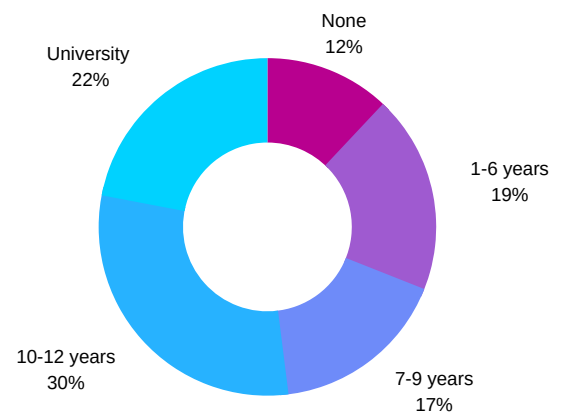

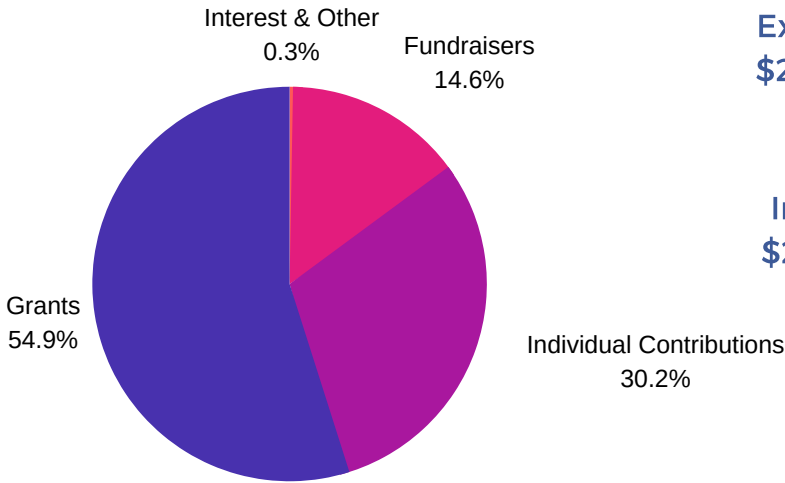
Level of Education in Country of Origin

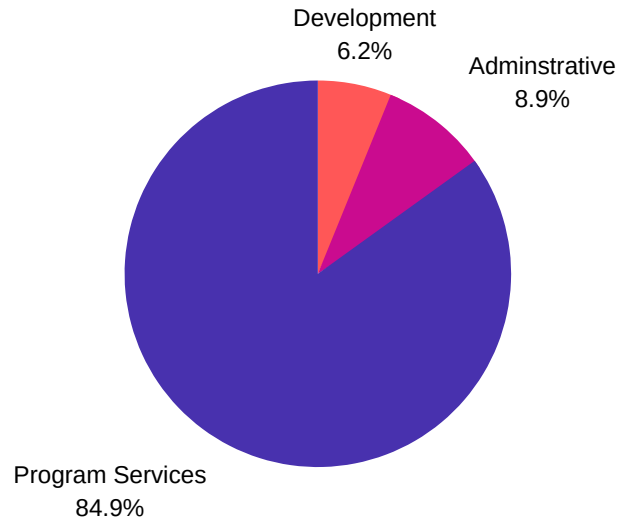
2018 Income
